MIKE'S MANIFESTO: Editor's note: I want to clarify, the Manifesto and the next article on Manna Principle go hand in hand. It really began the day before I was leaving for Illinois and the conference and all the meetings. I went to a men's prayer breakfast and to get my hair cut. At the men's breakfast, a person I had heard of numerous times, but never met, brought a short introduction to his ministry. A number of years ago he moved into his van to go around and do music and speaking to nursing homes. After the presentation, the Holy Spirit ministered a "loaded question" into my spirit. Would I live in my car to carry out His ministry? I had to think about the question in context. He did not say to me "go and live in your car." He said, "Would you be willing to?" I have thought about it a lot since then. I don't like the recognition I have come to. There is not necessarily anything wrong with where I am. But I have stayed where I am because it was easier to do it. It is so much easier being satisfied to hold back and settle for status quo. The old don't rock the boat. I am old, and not in good health, so just accept where I am and don't worry if I am being effective or not. I enjoyed some wonderful meetings and spending time with my

family, and then headed to the Chicago Suburb for the Boot Camp Revival Conference. I had already decided I couldn't do things at the conference. And I already decided what I WOULDN'T DO. I am not a stranger to this type of "services" but it is not me. So I came in with my mind already made up to be judgmental. AND I WAS. A couple things happened that started the revising of my attitude. And oh my word, did I ever need a revising attitude adjustment? You can watch the videos WHAT IN THE WORLD AM I THINKING AND GET INTO THE HARVEST, to hear some explanation. One of the things that caused me to refocus was just a POWERFUL time of prayer. The worship team leader called all the youth forward and all the leaders of the ministries involved in the conference forward. The youth prayed over the leaders first, and then reversed to the leaders praying for the youth. Oh how we do prayer in church service. Take twenty-five minutes to talk about how bad we have it, and then pray for two minutes and move on. NOT THIS TIME. I am pretty sure they did not plan for the prayer service to take so long. No showmanship, no one putting on a display, just PRAYER!! I felt the power of the Holy Spirit descend into that church in a way I haven't felt for years. THAT IS NOT HYPERBOLE. There was times when it was just a Holy silence. The manifestation of the Holy Spirit moving upon young people and upon leaders of ministry. The next day was a ministering in the bathroom that I accidentally walked in on. Since coming back to Iowa, God has been opening doors. I had a phone conversation and prayer time with a young Korean man who I was so blessed to meet at the conference. It was one of the most powerful prayer times I have had in years. We will be doing it every two weeks and adding others, including Micaela into the times. Through this time, Micaela and I may be making trips to the streets of Chicago to help in the work. In fact, I am in the process as I write this to plan within the upcoming American Mission trip to be in Chicago for a time. Micaela was invited to speak at a rally in Chattanooga, Tennessee. If she does or doesn't go this time, I fully believe she will be going. There is so much more to share of what is happening. Micaela's ministry in Paxton/Rantoul, Illinois is blasting off literally. And they are seeing genuine Holy Ghost revival in the children and youth. I don't know what is going to happen. But I know I haven't seen doors blast open like this for years. And all at the same time, ministry is happening in Iowa as well. We have so many stories to tell, I could fill this entire newsletter, and still not cover it. We have put things on the videos. WATCH!! I don't know how we are going to do it. We do not have the resources. But um, does God??

MANNA PRINCIPLE: (EDITOR'S NOTE: I know I have talked about this several times before. I want to take a moment in this writing and give God praise. His promises are never in vain. I have been reminded in conversations with my son this powerful principle I am still living under to this day.) Boy, do I ever remember January 2021. As I drove for hours and hours leaving Willcox, Arizona where I was discarded unceremoniously, and heading to Oskaloosa, Iowa to move into the church building, not a home. A winter storm was raging in the Midwest, and I was running full steam trying to stay ahead of it. I was trying to stay upbeat, but oh my. I had no job. I had little money. My main ministry supporter at that time; the woman who talked me in to restarting THE WARRIORS SWORD had died. If it weren't for the Omega Church, I would be homeless. I had no income except for just a couple people supporting the ministry. And that wasn't enough. I told God as I was driving I would do my very best to stay out of His way and just do what He told me. But I didn't even have any idea what that meant. After years and years of ministry, preaching revivals and helping churches, none of them wanted me anymore. I

was a "man without a country" and without a home and without a church. What was I going to do?? Uncertainty was an understatement. As best I could, over the hundreds and hundreds of miles, I tried to worship with the CDs playing loudly in the car. I stopped at a little Motel 6 in Kansas for the night. When I got up in the morning, the snow clouds were beginning to loom in the sky and I grabbed breakfast to go and started on the highway. It was just a couple hours into the last day of travel the Holy Spirit whispered something into my spirit. It went something like this. "I AM GOING TO GIVE YOU THE MANNA PRINCIPLE. I WILL NOT PROVIDE FOR YOU IN ADVANCE. I WILL PROVIDE FOR YOU EACH DAY. IF YOU TRY TO WORRY ABOUT ADVANCE, IT WILL NOT BRING YOU TO A GOOD PLACE. YOU MUST LEARN TO TRUST ME EVERY SINGLE MORNING YOU GET UP. YOU WILL CONTINUE TO DO FULL MINISTRY AND NOT BACK OFF FOR A SINGLE SECOND. I WILL PROVIDE FOR YOU EACH DAY. NOT IN ADVANCE." Wow, if I understood that at the time, I think I would have just moved into my car and gave up then. It is now 4 ½ years later. I spent a number of months living in the church building. I had no desire to ever pastor again. I would rather work at McDonalds than to put in effort to build things up just to be literally kicked out the door. But a few months in, God would place me in a church just to keep it open. That was four years ago. I HAVE NEVER GONE HUNGRY. I don't have all the things I wish I had, but never once did God ever fail to provide. And more than I ever thought. It rarely came from the way I expected. But "morning by morning new mercies I see. All I have needed Thy hand hath provided. Great is Thy faithfulness Lord unto me." Now, the Lord is blasting doors open for ministry. More and more ministry. We just have worked on our letter to our supporters, and I had to condense it into three pages just to try to part way contain all that is happening. You will see the launch of the AMMA below, and this is just shaping into a tremendous thing. And the restaurants and the website and the social media and what Micaela is doing in the schools and youth and, and, and I am willing to go to Africa. But I don't want to go to Chicago. And LOL, where does it appear I will go? And then I battled the Lord for weeks and finally gave in and contacted pastors. From Michigan to Arizona nonetheless. Where I said I would never go again. Um Lord, how does the Manna Principle work with all of this? We are praying about how to fund and accomplish all of this? Or should we even be doing that? I know the verses! Be still and know that I am God Ps. 46:10. They that wait upon the Lord Isa. 40:31. The battle belongs to the Lord I Samuel 17:47. When you have done all else, stand Eph. 6:13. Does that mean that we do nothing? We just sit and wait on God to do it? James 1:17-18 "Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. Yea, a man may say, thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works." Doing works does not challenge your faith!! It confirms it. God's promises are not temporary. II Corinthians 1:10-11 "Who DELIVERED us from so great a death, and DOTH DELIVER: in whom we trust that HE WILL YET DELIVER US; YE ALSO HELPING TOGETHER BY PRAYER FOR US, that for the gift bestowed upon us by the means of many persons thanks be given by many on our behalf." Do you see it? He delivered (past), He doth deliver (present), and He will yet deliver (future). The gift (support) given to us by means of many people, thanks is given by many on our behalf. WHAT A POWERFUL VERSE!! Past, Present, Future, God does not stop delivering!! And we are workers in His harvest field, so we must act upon our faith, and not just proclaim we have it. We may do some things you may or may not agree with. If I am gone extended, I will not collect from the church by my decision. So I may need to get a different job, however that would work. That is fine. But this is not because I am questioning the Manna Principle. For

God is Faithful, and we will work while standing and waiting and being still, not to question our faith, but to establish it!!

AMERICAN MISSION MINISTERIAL ASSOCIATION: Charles Spurgeon made a profound statement in his writings talking about ministry. I quote: "Paul had preached with simplicity and sincerity. If a minister is blessed with eloquent speech, are we more profited by him or might it be to our weakness? I sometimes wonder whether we should return to the the days of fishermen and give no ministers any education whatsoever. Perhaps we should just send ministers to preach the truth simply rather than give them all sorts of learning that is no earthly use to them but only helps them pervert the simplicity of God. OSWALD CHAMBERS: BEWARE OF HARKING BACK TO WHAT YOU WERE ONCE WHEN GOD WANTS YOU TO BE SOMETHING YOU HAVE NEVRE BEEN.

<u>ACTIONS CAN CAUSE RIPPLES:</u> A young member of Romania's Communist Youth Organization was once arrested and unmercifully beaten by a supposed Christian police officer. This incident hardened his heart toward Christ for the rest of his life. This missed opportunity for the gospel finally became the dictator of the former communist nation Romania. Nicolai Ceausescu was responsible for the torture of countless Christians including Pastor Richard Wurmbrand founder of Voice of the Martyrs. Even if you work at a prison, make sure you are keeping Christlikeness!

DO WE SETTLE FOR LESS?: I wonder how many times I settle for less than God's best because I don't want to do what it takes? It is so much easier to just comfort myself in my lack and status quo, rather than demanding of myself the Christlikeness that God desires for me. When God truly calls us, He demands from us Christlikeness and sacrifice as a disciple. And that doesn't come easy. Isaiah 48:10-11 "Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction. FOR MINE OWN SAKE, even for mine own sake, will I do it: For how should my name be polluted? And I will not give my glory unto another." If God loves us, then why do we have to face the fire. Because the fire purifies and cleanses. Why do bad things seem to repeatedly happen to good people? What shakes the faith is often what seems to be bad things, but are actually good things. When God allowed Job to be absolutely tested, for his friends to turn on him with false counsel, and for all he held dear to be destroyed, Job came out a much better man than he was before. Not because he was more moral or righteous, but because now he had not heard about God, He knew God! R.J. Stewart "A man is not complete in spiritual stature if all his mind, heart, soul, and strength are not given to God." We must never settle for things that may seem good and therein settle for less than the best. Chuck Milhuff: "I sin all I want to. I just don't want to... Why would I dig through the dumpster to find a halfeaten hot dog." John Piper "We do not yield to the offer of sandwich meat when we can smell the steak sizzling on the grill." Can you imagine sitting down beside a grill where the steak is cooking and saying, "I don't want to wait for the steak. I would rather just eat bologna." But when God is offering us so much, we settle for the scraps. Mankind has been doing it since the Garden. God gave them everything they could imagine and then some. Perfection! And they threw it away for a single bite of fruit. But no matter what we do, temptation to fall into less than the best is always there. Those who claim they do not face temptation are simply liars of the worst kind. D Campbell Morgan "Holiness is not freedom from temptation, but power to overcome temptation." With the temptation that is assuredly going to come, God gives us a way to escape it! I Corinthians 10:13. We cannot settle for less because falling into that trap offends God. A. Morgan Derham "Saying yes to God means saying no to things that offend His Holiness." God makes demands of us. But those demands are always to accomplish His purpose in our lives. And our purpose is to be Christlike. And to do that, we must always remember, it is about Him and not about us!! Oswald Chambers: "If my holiness is not drawing towards HIM, it is not holiness of the right order, but an influence that will awaken inordinate affection and lead souls away into side eddies. A beautiful saint may be a hindrance if he does not present Jesus Christ but only what Christ has done for him. He will leave the impression "what a fine character that man is!" That is not being a true friend of the Bridegroom (John 3:29); I am increasing all the time, HE IS NOT." When we are busy giving testimonies that exalt ourselves rather than God, then we do not have holiness at all! God should be manifested in all we do! Chambers "We look for God to manifest Himself to His children: God only manifests Himself IN His children...

Let not your heart be troubled... then am I hurting Jesus by allowing my heart to be troubled?" How often do we let our hearts be troubled? God does not just give commands for the sake of hearing Himself talk. He gives commands to make our lives better if we obey Him. We obey Him not by settling in our lives, but by taking up our cross daily and at times, walking directly into the fire. And we have no time to point our fingers at others trying to pick the speck out of their eye while the beam is in our own. John Bunyan "Forget others faults by remembering your own." And believe me, I have plenty to remember.

BLAMELESS AND HARMLESS: Philippians 2:14-16 "Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither labored in vain." There is so much in these verses! And I fear so few of us live by them. We can be blameless and harmless in our lives and be the sons of God. Shining as lights in the world holding forth the word of life. And we can do that fully in a wicked nation. In any form, does that sound like the church in America? Our nation is not godly, and we have not become godly because of the last election. While there have been some good actions taken, you don't have to watch much news to recognize who is in control of our nation. And like it or not, it is not Jesus. To quote a famous old book, with a slight edit, Satan is alive and well in America. But my friends, we must immediately and absolutely quit trying to use this as an excuse. Caeser was an evil vicious ruler of Rome. And at the same time Caiaphas was an absolutely evil high priest in Israel. And that was the rulers of government when the apostles set the world ablaze around them. If we would quit concerning ourselves with the unfixable corrupt Washington D.C. and the media that lies about it, and be about our Father's business, we could live without murmuring in the middle of a corrupt nation. But it takes a determination. One of my favorite people I ever got the opportunity to pastor, I have quoted before. JoAnne Duncan: "TODAY I WILL DO WHAT I SAY I BELIEVE." But as I have mentioned elsewhere, it is so easy to say we believe and never live like it. PSALMS 78:41 "Yea they turned back and tempted God, AND LIMITED THE HOLY ONE OF ISRAEL." We need to have absolute trust. When we don't we find ourselves turning back from what God says and limiting Him from what He can do. The nation of Israel literally LIMITED ALMIGHTY GOD in the blessings He could bring to them. David Wilkerson "Let me tell you something of Satan's strategy: If he cannot pull the Almighty out of His throne, he will try to tear God's image out of you – turning worshippers into murmurers and blasphemers." The murmuring is outlandish. Let me say, I don't frankly care what you feel about Donald Trump, nor is this article about that. But when you put your hope or your hatred upon a human being, you will find yourself eventually murmuring and complaining. How do you avoid these attitudes? EPHESIANS 3:20 "Now unto him that is ABLE TO DO EXCEEDING ABUNDANTLY ABOVE ALL THAT WE ASK OR THINK, ACCORDING TO THE POWER THAT WORKETH IN US." He can do abundantly more than you can ask or think. We are often saying CAN GOD CAN GOD CAN GOD, when we should be saying GOD CAN GOD CAN. If we actually started trusting in God, and actually living each day what we say we believe, we would find murmuring and complaining a thing of the past.

FOUNDATIONS: MATTHEW 7: Verses 24-29 tells the "parable" of the wise and foolish builders. While the parable teaches some great truths, I want to focus on something I think is often overlooked. It is found repeated in verse 25 and verse 27. "And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon the house." Maybe you wonder why I would highlight such a thing that is often disregarded? Let me tell you a fact. No matter if you build your house upon the rock or you build your house upon the sand, the rain and the floods and the wind are coming and they will beat upon your house. In Matthew 5:45 earlier in the Sermon on the Mount (the text is from the same sermon), it tells us the sun rises and the rain falls upon the just and the unjust alike. The fact that your "house" experiences the storms, has zero to do with what foundation you are built upon. However, the foundation you are built upon absolutely controls the results of those storms. And the true Rock foundation is only One! I Corinthians 3:11-15 "For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is JESUS CHRIST. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: For the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire." You make the choice of what you build upon your foundation. It may be gold, or it may be stubble. Whatever it is you build, no matter good or bad, it is going to be tested by fire!! No exception. The devil will lie to you and tell you if you were just a better Christian, or had more faith, or gave more offering, you would not face the struggles. The fire, or the wind, or the rain or the floods. In other words, if you just had built on the Rock, these trials would not come. And church people, much like the friends of Job, love to spew out the lies the enemy feeds them. I have heard it numerous times in counseling. "What did I do that has turned God against me?" But that is an absolutely false premise. Yes, it is a necessity to build your house on the Rock. But recognize, as you build, the devil will never be happy with your building, And he will work against you always. Don't get lazy and start using sand for your foundation. It is easier. It is more pliable. But it won't stand. You may think, well I used Gold. That has to be pleasing to the Master? It is!! And when the fire comes, the gold will not be destroyed but purified into a Masterpiece. The stubble will burn up. So the foundation and the building material is vital. But do not be deceived. The issues will still come against you. But it will not destroy you! In fact, in the long run, it will instead make you better, because Jesus Christ will never fail! Ever!
