MIKE’S MANIFESTO: PART 3 THE THIRD LETTER IN HAFT, THE HANDLE OF THE SWORD, IS F. FAITHFUL: Faithful is not even a word that can be used when things go as you have planned. ALABASTER BREAK by Lizzie Morgan “you don’t know the cost of the oil; you don’t know the cost of my worship.” This is the reference to Mary who broke the oil over Jesus and wiped His feet with her hair. It was expensive, but her worship was much more expensive than the cost of mere oil. Paul wrote: II Corinthains 4:8-10 “We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of

Jesus might be made manifest in our body.” A quote that is accredited to numerous people: “Ministry- others being blessed by the oil that came from what crushed you.” It is not a pleasant fact, and not one that modern day theology likes to look at. We don’t like to do messages on Paul saying they were troubled from every side. For it is taught we can have victory without struggle and glory without the cross. But to truly be faithful in ministry, it is often the oil that came from your crushing that brings the benefit. You cannot make wine without first crushing the grapes. In fact, the grapes are “stomped” into liquid. If you want to be faithful, it is not how you act on the mountain top, but rather it is when you are being crushed into the oil that brings the worship to the God you claim to praise. A few years back, a group of five missionaries trying to bring clean water to Mosul, Iraq was massacred in an attack against them. A few days from that, in the same type of attack, vehicles riddled with bullets, yet a military patrol walked away with only minor injuries. Why do some die while others are supernaturally protected? Why did James get beheaded, and God sent an angel to deliver Peter from the same prison?

Jim Elliott wrote “You are immortal until your work is finished.” His prayer “God I pray Thee, light these idle sticks of my life and may I burn up for Thee. Consume my life, my God, for it is Thine. I seek not a long life, but a full one, like You, Lord Jesus.” “He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain what he cannot lose.” Elliott wisely realized it is not the length of our life that matters. It is the fullness of our life in bringing glory to Our God! Everyone will lose our lives in some fashion, whether to sickness, old age, or a sniper’s bullet. But if we want to be faithful, circumstances play no part. And God does not owe us an explanation. Be careful in asking for one. Or you might find yourself standing as Job hearing God say, “Put on your pants like a man and I will talk to you like a man. Who do you think you are?” Being faithful is not asking God to explain Himself. Being faithful is putting your nose in His back and following Him wherever He takes you. Whether that be to do a major crusade, or to witness to a homeless person where no one will ever know what you did. The fact is not in what you did at all! It is in your willingness to be obedient for obedience is better than sacrifice. I Samuel 15:22. We are told to Occupy until He comes back! Luke 19:13. There is nothing that gives a qualification to only do that when things are good. Those who have been faithful to being disciples of Christ will give up father, mother, children, spouse, land, and all. If you think being a disciple is an easy call on your life, you don’t understand discipleship at all. We are in a time when Jesus said Himself that men’s hearts would be failing for fear. Luke 21:26. I don't want drama with this writing, just to set the record straight about something I just watched that set off a righteous anger in me. If you don't believe in righteous anger you never read about Jesus flipping tables in the temple, or Moses when he threw the first 10 commandment tablets to the ground when the Israelites were worshiping the golden calf. First, let me say I understand fully this lady had no idea what she was talking about. I don't condemn her for not understanding the topic. However, I am angry at her saying her stance was biblical. So let me give you the run down. I will not name names as I don't want to start drama; just bring awareness. This Youtuber whom I watch often makes homemaking videos and discusses topics she feels like needs to be talked about more. For the most part, I have no issues with her videos. With her being of a Catholic background and I am Protestant background, we butt heads on theology. I am in no way saying she needs to believe what I believe. Her video titled "Say goodbye to mom rage" made me curious as to what she would say. What works for you may not work for the person next to you. And that is ok! We are all

different. So I like to watch things about the topics I'm struggling or have struggled with. Right off the bat it was said "Anger is a capital sin" first things first, sin is sin. James 2:10 ESV - "For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become guilty of it all." The "capital sin" claim is false. There is one sin in the entire bible labeled worse than the rest and that is blasphemy of the Holy Spirit. Which in case you didn't know, isn't anger. Can it be done in anger? Absolutely. But that is why we must take what Paul said to heart when we struggle with anger. Ephesians 4:26-27 ESV – "Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, and give no opportunity to the devil." Let's look at that first part "be angry and do not sin" hmmm almost like the Bible itself is saying anger is NOT a sin but you can sin because of anger. So why tell impressionable mothers that they are sinning for being frustrated at an overly messy home, the lack of being able to eat properly, and care for themselves properly? She then talked about the scenario of the busy mom who grabs a quick coffee and a donut at 9am then by 12pm crashes and is an emotional mess; I've been there. A few moments later stated, "and this can be seen as gluttony, eating something for pleasure instead of nourishment." Let's look at the definition of gluttony shall we? Gluttony " habitable greed or excess in eating" Gluttony is an OVERINDULGENCE! To the busy mom who had to run out the door, knew you needed to eat, and just simply grabbed a donut so you wouldn't feel sick; you are not gluttonous. That is in NO way gluttony. I couldn't watch any more after that. My heart was raging and my stomach felt sick. There are women right now that beat themselves up daily because they can't always keep a level head. Ones who cry themselves to sleep because they are so exhausted with the weight of motherhood and snap. I see you. You are not some capital sinner who needs to be on their knees for the next 20 days in repentance. Motherhood is hard and it can be overwhelming. Videos like this can cause unnecessary judgment on yourself and can even warp other mom's views on friends that are dealing with this. Mom rage is real, and God wants to help you with it. Jesus can't come clean your house for you, but He wants you to lay that overbearing burden at His feet.
